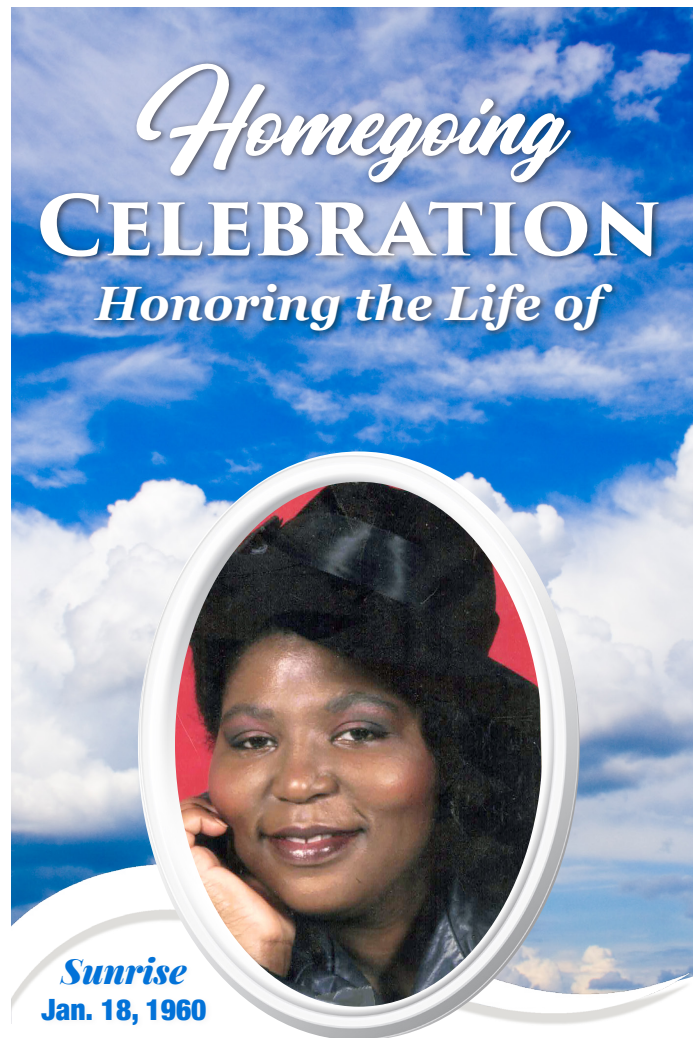
TO MY DEAR SISTER
