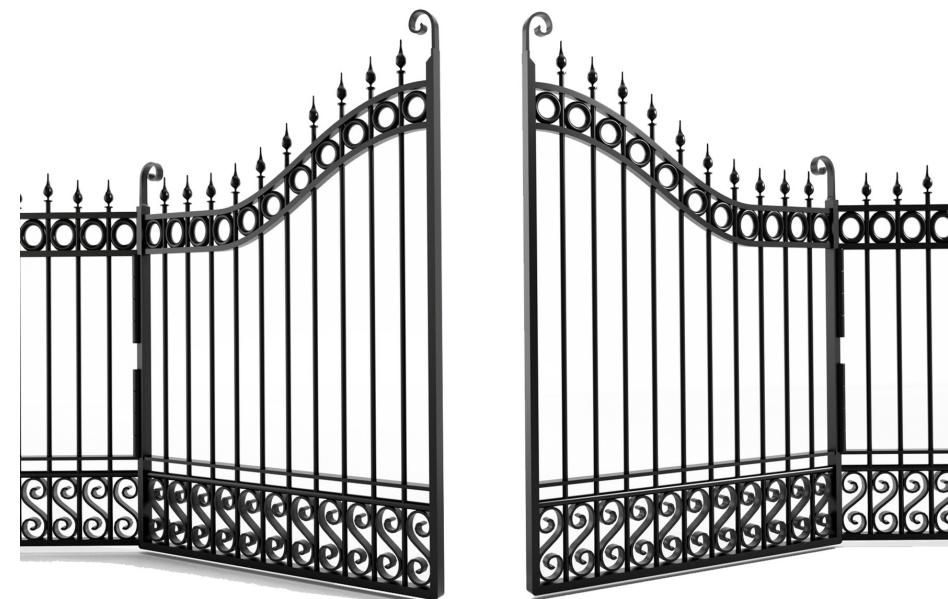


MIRANDA COLETTE BRADY CHRISTIAN, at the age of 47, departed on December 5th, 2022, in Chapel Hill, North Carolina.
