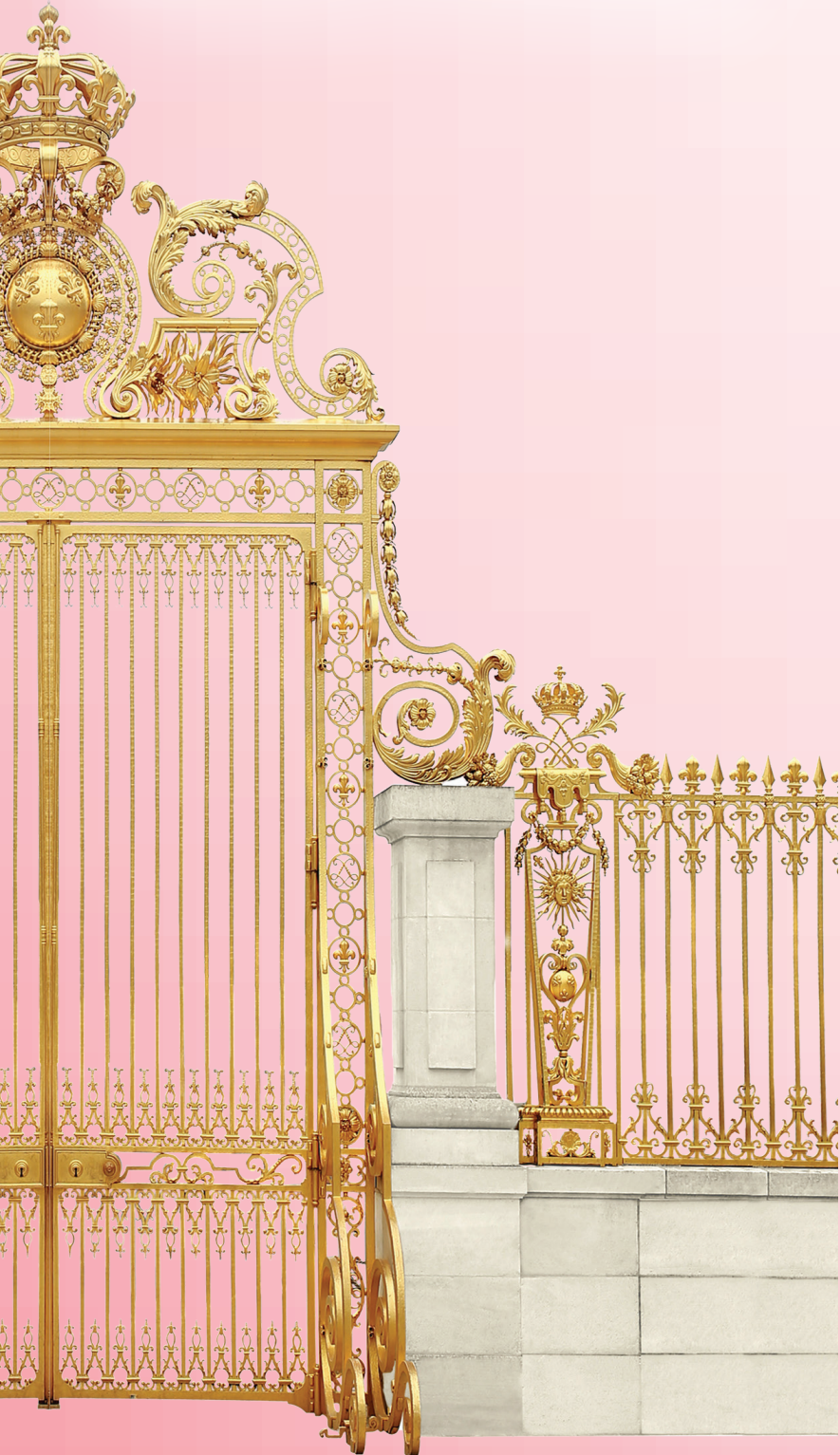

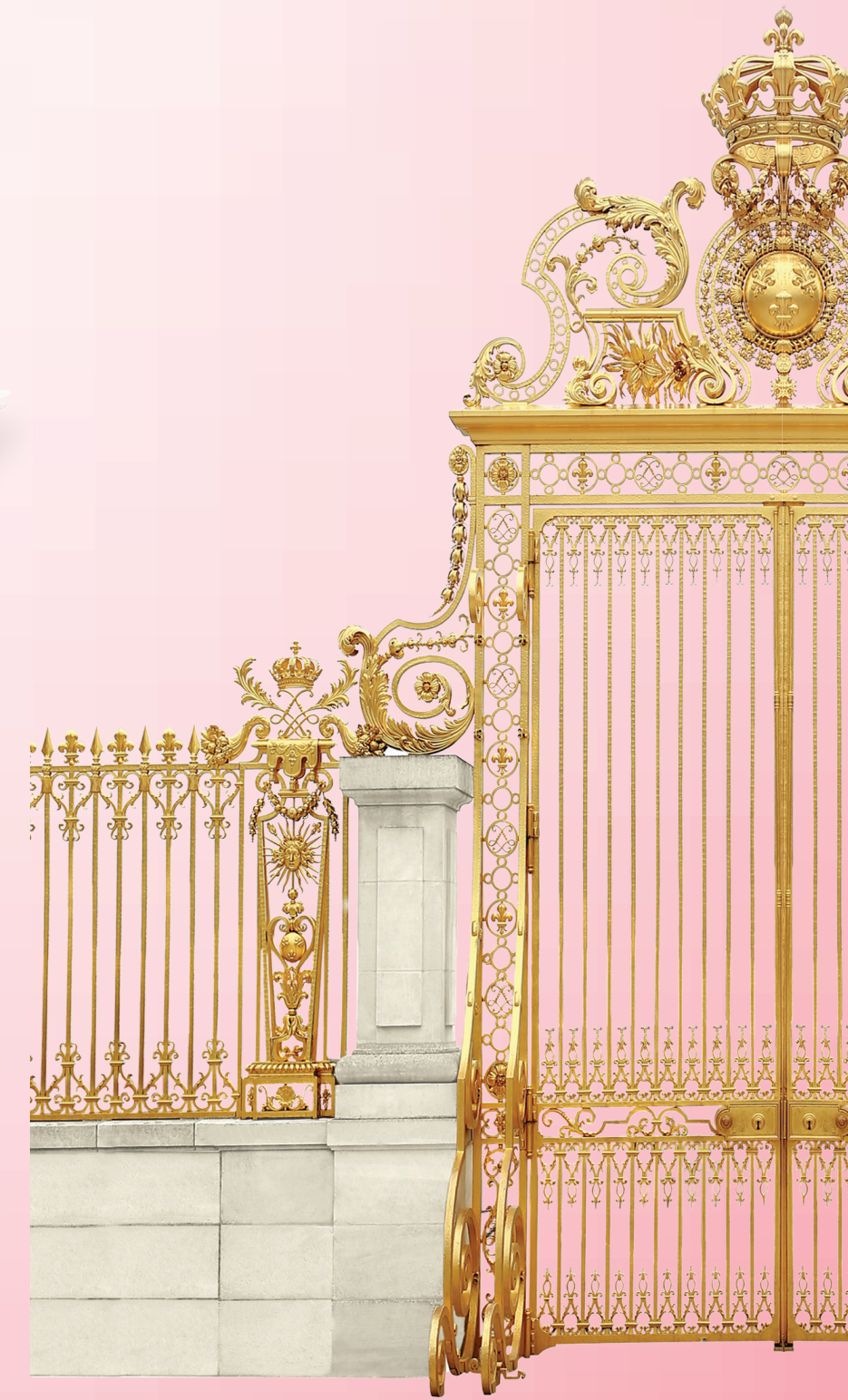

OBITUARY

JANEEN DASHEA SMITH was born on June 3, 1984, in Georgetown, SC. She departed this life on the evening of October 3, 2023, at Cape Fear Valley Hospital.

She accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior and was baptized at an early age. Janeen served for many years at Jesus World Outreach Center in Fayetteville, NC.

Janeen attended public schools in Georgetown, SC, and graduated from Georgetown High School in 2002. After graduation, she entered Fayetteville State University in Fayetteville, NC, where she earned her Bachelors of Science degree in Mathematics. Janeen was very skilled and had many talents. She was a proud Georgetown Bulldogs cheerleader in high school as well as a co-captain of the Fayetteville State University Broncos Cheerleading Squad. Upon completion of her advanced studies, Janeen received a Master of Science degree in Higher Education from Walden University in 2014.

She taught sixth and eighth grade Mathematics for eight years at Westover Middle School in Fayetteville. During her tenure as an educator for the Cumberland County school system, she still maintained her passion for cheerleading. Janeen gracefully accepted the position as the Cheer Coach for Westover High School where she coached for two years. In 2019, she was commissioned in the United States Army as a Field Artillery Officer. She served the majority of her four years on active duty at Ft. Liberty, NC. Janeen was medically retired from the Army in 2023. She began her civilian career with Federal Information Systems (FIS). She worked as an Informations System Trainer.

Janeen was preceded in death by her biological mother, Barbara Smith, and father, Robert Kinloch.

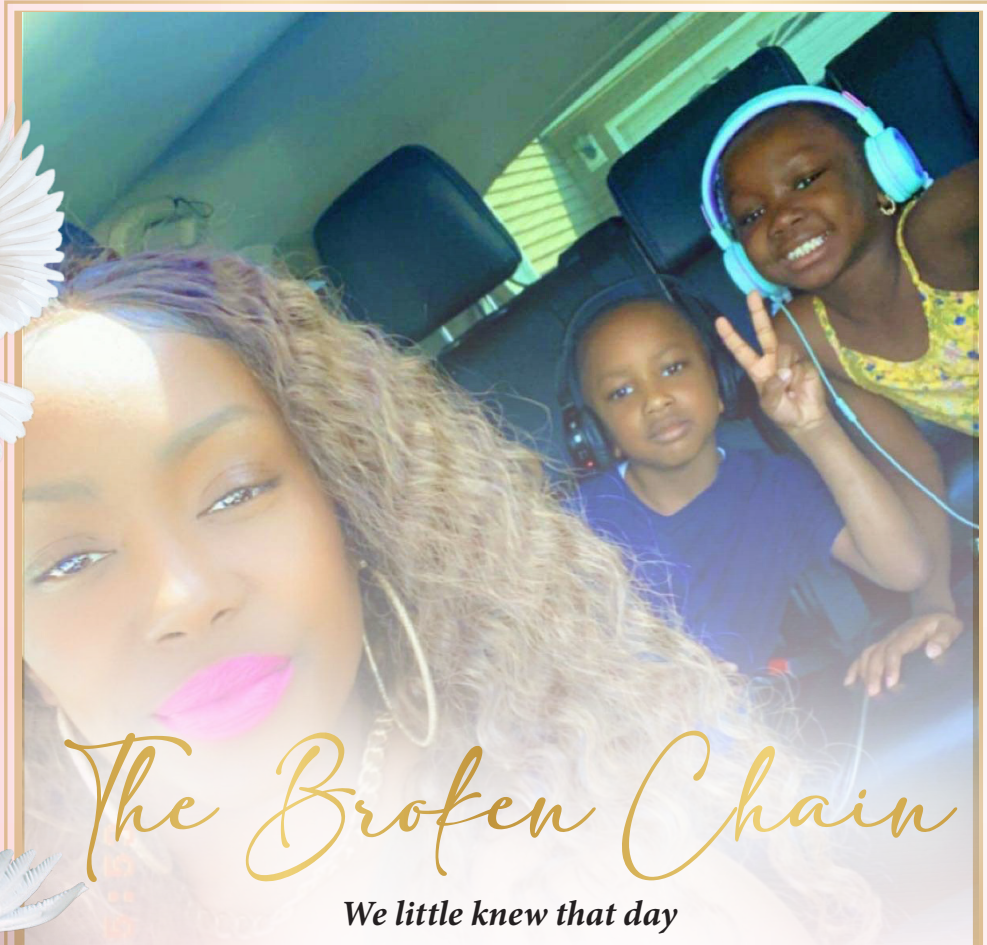
